Dear Parent,

The school year is almost at an end and we want to celebrate your child's success. We are organizing a summer camp for our students!

This camping outing is an appreciation of our students' dedication to learning. We always emphasize that their learning at school will shape their future. Yet, we know that 'all work and no fun' is not balanced either, so we have chosen a place where we can swim, play ball, hike, laugh and develop lasting memories.

We wish to organize a summer camp every year. Students will be invited to attend our summer camp based on their academic achievements and overall behavior throughout the year. Eventually, outings like "summer camp" will help us create an academic and social environment that encourages **SUCCESS**.

DETAILS:

When: We plan to leave from the school parking lot on the morning of **June 20th, Sunday about 8 a.m.** and return to school in the evening of **Tuesday, June 22nd, about 8pm.**

Where: [Pine Mountain Club in Frazier Park \(Northwest of Los Angeles\)](#)

Eligibility: We plan to select about 10-12 students based on the following criteria: Good GPA, good behavior record, teacher recommendation and motivation!

Cost: \$120 (includes everything— transportation, stay, food, etc.) Hopefully, we want to collect the whole amount before **Friday, June 18th**. If you can't pay the whole amount by that date, please contact me and we can make arrangements.

Permission slips: Permission slips are to be turned in to Mr. Bidak by **Friday, June 11th**. You will hear during the last week of school from Mr. Bidak whether your application is accepted or not.

Health & Safety: We will buy adequate amount of food, and serve breakfast, lunch and dinner to make sure your children get enough nutrition. We will have an emergency kit with us in case we need it. If there is special medicine that your child should use, make sure you advise us on that. The camp area is safe and well known. We have had a summer camp at Pine Mountain Club before. Our sister schools in LA have also been camping there for several years. Frazier Park is not isolated from the civilization; rather, it is in a neighborhood of residences and recreation areas. Supervision: We will have at least two teachers (Mr. Ozkay & Mr. Bidak), one or two teacher aids and a parent supervising your children at all times. We will have visitors time to time such as the principal. We are designing the program so that we will be together all the time to maximize synergy and supervision.

Possible Activities: Hiking, Basketball, Soccer, Sightseeing, Swimming, Feeding Horses, Picnics and so on. These activities are available at the Pine Mountain Club. We will try to fit as many of these activities as we can when we finalize the daily activities plan. As always, we keep in mind that your children's safety is the top priority, followed by the learning, social and fun outcomes of these activities.

What your child needs to bring:

- *Clothes:* Your child should have enough clothes for three days including sleeping clothes and T-shirts/shorts for outdoor activities including swimming. We advise sweaters in case it gets cold at night. Sports shoes and slippers will be handy.
- Please bring a *sleeping bag*, too, if you have one. Remember to bring a towel, toothbrush/toothpaste, shampoo, etc. You can bring a backpack to carry clothes, snacks, etc.
- Students may bring books for reading, and they are allowed to bring electronic games, board games, and other types of games to play with their friends.

Meals: (The following is the menu we had planned out in our last camp. It might change.)

Breakfast: waffles, bagels, muffin, cereal, juices, milk

Lunch: pizza, hot dog, snacks

Dinner: ravioli, chicken taquitos, spaghetti, fish sticks, chicken egg rolls

Extra: brownie, fruit mixes, nuts, nesquik, popcorn, snacks, cookies, ice-cream, etc.

RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

All participants, including chaperones, in the activity described below must read and sign this agreement. If the participant is under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must read this agreement, agree that the minor may participate in the activity described below and sign the agreement on the minor's behalf. The minor must also read and sign this agreement.

1. RELEASE FROM LIABILITY. For and in consideration of permitting _____ (the "Participant") to participate in the voluntary and non-school sponsored activities (the Activities) during the _____ to _____ charter school year, I hereby voluntarily release, discharge, waive and relinquish any and all claims or causes of action, including but not limited to negligence and strict liability, for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death arising from the Participant's participation in, or activities related to, the Activities against *Charter School* and/or its officers, agents, employees or volunteers (collectively "*Charter School*"). I also expressly agree to release, discharge, waive and hold harmless *Charter School* from any act or omission of negligence in rendering or failing to render any type of emergency or medical services. In signing this agreement, I fully recognize and understand that if I am injured, die or my property is damaged, I am giving up my rights (as well as the rights of my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns) to make a claim or file a lawsuit against *Charter School* even if they negligently or by some other act or omission cause the injury, death or damage.

2. ASSUMPTION OF RISK, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE. I hereby acknowledge I have voluntarily chosen to participate in the Activities. I understand that while *Charter School* may be making arrangements related to the Activities, it is not a school-sponsored activity, and *Charter School* is not [*identify any services or responsibilities that the Participant may assume the charter school is undertaking.*] I understand that many activities during the Activities may have risks and hazards where injury, death or property damage can occur. I understand there are risks in going on the Activities, including but not limited to injury, death or property damage. Additionally, I understand that emergency medical services may not be available during these Activities. I hereby acknowledge that I intend to assume all risks and to exempt, release and relieve *Charter School* from any and all liability, including strict liability, for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death, including that caused by negligence.

3. INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS. I, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, agree to hold harmless and indemnify the *Charter School* from any and all claims, including any and all defense costs, (which shall include attorney's fees), incurred in connection with the claims for bodily injury, wrongful death or property damage, sustained by me, or in connection with claims for bodily injury, wrongful death or property damage sustained by third parties which may have been caused by me, whether negligent or not, in the course of my participation in the Activities.

4. PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES AND REPRESENTATIONS. I hereby agree to follow all rules, regulations, and instruction of *Charter School* while on the Activities. I also represent that I am physically and mentally capable of participating in the Activities.

5. CALIFORNIA LAW AND VENUE. I agree that this agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with California law. In the event any legal action is commenced to enforce or interpret the provisions of this agreement, the venue for any such action shall be in the State of California. The courts or laws of any other state of the United States, United States Federal courts, or the courts of any other nation, shall not have jurisdiction over this agreement and the enforcement of its provisions.

I acknowledge that I have read the foregoing Release from Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, and I am fully aware of the potential dangers and risks inherent and incidental to participating in the Trip. I am fully aware of the effect of signing this written instrument. I voluntarily sign my name as evidence of my acceptance of the above provisions.
